



Company Safety Policy

Aqua-Tech Cleaning Specialists accepts that it has a moral and legal responsibility for the health, safety and welfare of its employees and others who may be affected by its operations. It is therefore the policy of the company that all works will be carried out in such a manner as to ensure so far as reasonably practical the health, safety and welfare of all its employees, sub contractors and members of the public.

The company is recognizing that injury, damage and loss can be avoided and that consideration of health, safety and welfare should rank equally with all other commercial considerations, have appointed N.Trunks with overall responsibility for implementing this policy.

For this policy to be effective it requires joint co-operation of the company and individual employees. The company for its part will ensure that sufficient finances are available to provide:

- 1) Places to work that are safe and without risks to health.
- 2) Safe methods of working.
- 3) Equipment that is safe without risks to health.
- 4) Information, instruction, training and supervision to ensure the health and safety at work of all employees.
- 5) Reasonable welfare facilities.

The Employees contribution to implementing the company policy, in addition to their specific legal responsibilities, is to develop a concern for their own safety and that of others who may be affected by acts or omissions at work.
